RESORT VILLAGE OF PEBBLE BAYE

BYLAW NO 3-2015

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES

The Council of the Resort Village of Pebble Baye in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Resort Village of Pebble Baye.
2. The administrator, together with another person designated by council to sign cheques on its behalf, is hereby authorized to pay certain accounts either by cheques or by electronic transfer in a timely fashion, namely:
 - a) wages and salaries payable to municipal employees;
 - b) employee payroll deductions, including municipal contributions;
 - c) telephone, heat, power services, insurance and landfill tipping fees;
 - d) collections on behalf of other taxing authorities;
 - e) Payment of bills for projects that have been previously approved by council.
3. The administrator shall advise council at its next regular meeting of the particulars of transactions undertaken in accordance with section 2 of this bylaw, including but not limited to:
 - a) the transaction date
 - b) the amount paid
 - c) the payee
4. Members of council are hereby authorized to expend for repairs in the case of an emergency to a public works an amount not exceeding \$ 1,000.00, with the agreement of one other council member prior to the expenditure.
5. When a member of council authorizes an expenditure in accordance with section 4 of this bylaw, the member shall advise council at its next meeting the amount and nature of the expenditure.
