Council met this past Friday March 20<sup>th</sup>. There has been a lot of melting over the past week and there is virtually no snow left on the lake. The grid roads getting into the development are soft and muddy so be prepared for a messy trip in and out of the development. If you have an ice shack on the lake, be prepared for some work getting them off as there is several inches of water sitting on the ice. If the weather gets a little colder which it is forecast for the next week they may be frozen into the ice. The shacks have to be removed from the ice surface by March 31<sup>st</sup>. I would like to thank Don Mutch and Guy Caron for plowing our roads this past winter. It is much appreciated. The skating rink is finished for another year and the skate warm up shack will be put away over the next few days while we still have some snow on our roads. A big thanks to Don Harder for building, maintaining and keeping the rink clean for people to use.

Back to council news. We went through and finalized our budget for 2026 and the good news is there won't be any tax increases this coming year. Our Audit is near completion and we should have it back and finalized by next month. After several years of work the sale of the Buffer strip has now been approved by the government and the sale of the land to the land owners off Sunridge place can now take place. The monies obtained from this sale will go into an account that we will use for some projects in our village that have yet to be determined. The Assessment notices will be sent out this Friday the 27<sup>th</sup> as well as a self stamped addressed envelope for those people who still have not signed the document that allows us to use email instead of mailing which will save us many hundreds of dollars over a year. The letter giving us permission to use your email can also be found on our web site. We need your permission to send stuff to you via email such as assessment notices, receipts and monthly letters due to privacy laws. We are hoping to have a metal recycling bin for a month over the summer like we did last year to help keep our village clean. We will also be having a Fire Smart meeting in May to have our village checked to see any areas we can improve on to keep fire risk low. Our next meeting will be Friday April 24<sup>th</sup> at the Maintenance shop.
